I swim on A days during 3<sup>rd</sup> hour with Ashlea's P.E. class.






On swimming days, my teacher will tell me when it's time to go to the **bathroom** and put on my **swim suit**.







When my swim suit is on, my teacher will walk with me to the pool. I will sit on the bleachers and wait with the other students.



The teacher tells everyone when it's **time to get in** the pool.








The students get to swim and play for about minutes.



My teacher will tell me when I have 5 more minutes left to swim. Swimming time is almost finished.




The teacher will tell everyone when it's time to get out of the pool. The other students will try to follow the rules and get out when the teacher tells them. This is a good thing to do.
