FOR PRACTICING 1ST LETTER SOUNDS




30 UNIQUE GAME SHEETS

Challenge kids to write down items that begin with each letter. They'll be practicing letter recognition, first letter sounds, handwriting, and spelling!

- Have them think of words that start with each letter
- You can give them a theme (animals, sports, school supplies, kids' names, colors, etc.)
- They can play individually, in small groups, or as a whole class
- Give it as homework for them to use at the grocery store, on errands, at a sporting event, or at a restaurant - they can have a new sheet each week
- Give everyone the same sheet and then have the class share all the T words they thought of
- Spell all of the words out loud
