Spelling Bingo

BINGO is a fun way to help kids learn their weekly spelling words. You can use The Trip Clip to [make your own spelling BINGO games](#) using any spelling list you want, or you can buy [pre-made boards](#) from The Trip Clip that use the spelling curriculum found on the K12 Reader website. The Trip Clip has a full year spelling curriculum.

Math Bingo

Instead of having kids do worksheets, play this game to practice the same skills while keeping kids engaged and having fun. This FREE PDF has math equations on the calling cards and answers on the BINGO board. Each of the calling cards contains a 1-digit addition problem that doesn't require any carrying. The BINGO board contains the answers to the 25 math problems. To play, choose a random calling card, read out the equation (write it down, too, for kids who are more visual), and ask student(s) to mark a square that contains the answer. When they get 5 in a row in any direction, they win! You can also get 30 bingo boards so a whole class can play at once, or make your own math bingo with problems that meet your students where they are.

Alphabet bingo

Alphabet bingo is great on road trips, trips around town, and in the classroom! When you're traveling, kids can look for the letters on signs and try to find them all, or two kids can play together to see who can get 5 in a row first. You can make it harder by looking only at first letters. In the classroom, you can play it like a regular Bingo game to work on letter recognition or first letter sounds. The learning opportunities here are limited only by your imagination!

Icebreaker Bingo

This Bingo board is a great ice breaker for the first day of school. Give every child a board and have them mix and mingle to try to find kids to match each square. When they find a match, they can write that child's name in the square – little kids may want to hand off the board to have the other child write their OWN name in the square! You can see who gets a Bingo (5 in a row in any direction) first, or you can just have them keep going until they find as many matches as they can. When they're done, you can go through each square as a group and have kids raise their hands to say the name of who they found for each square. Eventually you'll know all the kids who have a dog, who speak another language, and who like brussels sprouts!
